5. To develop an effective youth ministry and standardized Sunday School Program.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Task the DEUS Sunday School Program Committee to develop an outline for a standardized Anglican Sunday School Program to be presented at DEUS Synod 2008</li> </ul>
6. To improve internal and external communication throughout DEUS and the APA.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Select a DEUS Information Manager to perform an information assessment with recommendations to be presented at DEUS Synod 2008.</li> </ul>
7. To revitalize the richness of music in Anglican Worship Services.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Select an organist/choir master to develop a plan to encourage/promote and revitalize the use of music in worship services.</li> </ul>
